
Exposure: Prior to every scheduled SAT/ACT exam. College Connection cobbles together a group of 8-10 students. at its Midtown Manhattan office, to conduct a series of three to five SAT/ACT practice exams. Finally, at the conclusion of each practice exam, Sam, and the student test-takers, engage in a directed discussion, focusing on the more difficult questions contained in the exam.
